Reminders, Upcoming Events and Other Bits of Information

- · We've heard a few little whispers of possible snow week... if weather is extreme and we are ever unable to open or need to open later/close earlier due to staff struggling to get into school you will be notified via ClassDojo, email and the Federation Facebook page. If you haven't heard anything from us on an extreme weather day we are open as normal.
 - · We have lots of coughs and colds going around so we will be encouraging good hygiene practices including regular hand washing.
- · Sickness and diarrhoea please can we ask that if your child has had sickness or diarrhoea that they are kept off school for 48 hours after the episode of illness to ensure they are clear of the bug before they return. Please do not be offended if we send your child home if they have not been off for 48 hours after stomach bugs.
- · If your child is going to be absent please make sure you are leaving a voicemail on the schools phone for office staff to pick up first thing. Please do not send messages via email or dojo to the office or your child's class teacher as these are not always picked up first thing and we may still phone you.

The children are having a wonderful day wearing their spots and Pudsey clothes, we have been so impressed with our super runners across the Federation and our star bakers at the Juniors!
